



Montblanc obtains injunction against sale of counterfeits online

In a final ex parte order the Delhi High Court confirmed Montblanc the owner of the MONTBLANC and MEISTERSTUCK marks and the Three Ring / Star Device, and granted a permanent injunction against the defendants. The defendants, an e-commerce portal, were found to be copying, counterfeiting and marketing Montblanc's products through their website. The bench accepted that the defendants habitually sold counterfeit products and on a complaint to the Cyber Cell, an FIR had been registered against them as well.
